Kalak is the name of an Inca warrior who was about to marry the most beautiful princess of all tribes, named Fa. Their legend is told since generations and gave its name to the mountains that fronts the vineyard. Kalak is thus and also the legenday blend of Vina Marty.

It is produced from grapes that grow on the foothills of the Andes Mountains. During the day, temperatures amplitude enable the growth of exceptional quality fruits.

DENOMINATION OF ORIGIN - RAPEL VALLEY

Rapel Valley englobes both Cachapoal D.O (Septentrional) and Colchagua D.O (Meridional). The first is known for both its complex carménères and elegant and fresh cabernets, and the other for enhancing the potential of Syrah.

WINE PROFILE

BLEND : Carmenere, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Cabernet Franc

HARVEST: By hand

FARMING: Sustainable

WINEMAKING: Traditional in stainless steel tanks with an average length of 30 days, and temperatures about 24–26°C.

AGEING: 12 to 16 months in French oak barrels, 50% new and 50% used.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep Cherry with Ruby hues

Nose: Pronounced intensity of aromas and complexity due to the mixing of the different varieties: red and black fruits are combined with spices, reminiscent of tobacco and black pepper. Delicate notes of vanilla come out subtly.

Palate: Elegant and sophisticated, the fruit flavours and sweet spices with firm but polished tannins are well balanced with a refreshing acidity. This wine is very complex and should be a perfect fit for meat.
