Available in Carmenere, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah, these vibrant wines express the best of these varietals in Chile. The vines are located 2600 ft high, in the foothills of the Andes mountains.

## **DENOMINATION OF ORIGIN - ALTO MAIPO**

Best known for red wines production due to its mild climate, it is the closest region to Santiago. Rocky alluvial soils are found here which are ideal for the red varietals. The mountains have an influence on the vineyard's microclimate due to the altitude, the cool breezes in the evenings that cool down the vineyard temperature, and a higher temperatureduring the day. This specific growing region is well known for producing the best Cabernets from Chile but it is also ideal for Syrah and Merlot

#### **TASTING NOTES**

## Colour: Deep ruby red.

**Nose:** The aromas are showing typical characters for Syrah such as spices, black pepper, and dark fruit, enhanced by developed notes like animal, toasty, and leather. Also mineral, smoky and earthy notes reflect the potential of this Syrah.

Palate: Overall, it has a beautiful balance between fruit flavours and acidity. Silky and round tannins give this wine a soft medium to full body. It can be found a high concentration of developed characters like mocha, earthy, bacon toasty and spices that are predominant until the end. It is an intense and powerful wine.
